



Beginning the week of Monday, June 19th, construction crews will be excavating and grinding US 20 from South Buckaroo Trail towards Bend. A single lane of traffic will be maintained in each direction; however turn lanes and center median will be closed for construction. Work will be done during the daytime hours from 7am to 5pm. Following this work, mainline paving of US 20 will begin. No work will be performed over weekend.

This work is part of the larger US 20: OR 126 Junction to Deschutes River Bridge project that will repave approximately 15 miles of US 20 from Sisters to Tumalo. Work will also include signing improvements at the intersections of US 20 and Gist Rd., Cloverdale Rd. and Fryrear Rd. Paving work will be done at night between 8 pm and 7 am, Sunday through Friday. Travelers can expect flagger controlled lane restrictions and delays up to 20 minutes through the work zone. Work is expected to be complete by the end of September. Once complete, durable striping, centerline rumble strips, and recessed pavement markers will be installed.
